New Year 12 Induction Tasks: 2017

(Get started on these over the summer hols!)

Tasks for A Level Theatre Studies students over the summer:

1. Learn a published monologue* of your choice ready for an audition during the first week of the new term.
2. Create a two page information document on **two** of the following theatre practitioners: Stanislavsky, Brecht, Artaud, Boal, Grotowski, Berkoff: Examine their methods, ideologies and practice in relation to their approach to creating theatre. Design the document in as interesting and imaginative a way so it can be displayed! Don't just cut and paste!
3. Theatre Studies students may also read our two texts for Unit 3: 'Colder than Here' by Laura Wade and 'Woyzeck' by George Buchner. (copies available from EJS)
4. Over the summer, try to go and see a live theatre production if you can. Its good experience!

All tasks must be completed by the start of September as they will be referred to during your induction fortnight at the start of the course.

The performance task will be used to judge your suitability for the A Level course alongside your GCSE result, so please prepare thoroughly.

Please remember to ALWAYS dress appropriately for Theatre Studies lessons - i.e. tracksuit bottoms/leggings and trainers. You must always be ready to participate in practical work as this forms the foundation of what we do in this subject area.
